CONSENT ORDER

JURISDICTION AND PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The Virginia Board of Medicine (“Board”) and Louis Beverly Brill, II, M.D., as evidenced by their signatures hereto, in lieu of proceeding to an informal conference, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Dr. Brill’s license to practice medicine and surgery in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Louis Beverly Brill, II, M.D. was issued License Number 0101-242320 to practice medicine and surgery on August 6, 2007, which is scheduled to expire on January 31, 2018.
2. Dr. Brill violated Virginia Code § 54.1-2915(A)(3), (13) and (16) in his care and treatment of Patient A, a 55-year-old male. Specifically, upon examination of the excised tissue, on or about August 1, 2013, Dr. Brill diagnosed “changes consistent with tonsillitis.” In September 2014, the patient discovered a palpable nodule in the right submandibular region of his throat, which was aspirated on October 20, 2014, and determined to be squamous cell carcinoma. In December 2014, another pathologist reexamined the original pathology tissue, determined that Dr. Brill’s diagnosis had been incorrect, and found that the specimen showed “squamous cell carcinoma poorly differentiated.” Histologic evidence showed that the poor differentiation of the malignant cells clearly distinguished them from the surrounding benign lymphocytes, and the tumor was present in approximately 80% of

the excised tissue. Dr. Brill's erroneous diagnosis resulted in a fourteen month delay in the diagnosis and treatment of Patient A's cancer.

CONSENT

Louis Beverly Brill, II, M.D., by affixing his signature to this Consent Order, agrees to the following:

1. I have been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document and am represented by Paige Levy Smith, Esq.;

2. I am fully aware that without my consent, no legal action can be taken against me or my license except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, Virginia Code § 2.2-4000 *et seq.*;

3. I acknowledge that I have the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact-finding conference before the Board; and the right to representation by counsel;

4. I waive my right to an informal conference;

5. I admit to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waive my right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and any sanction imposed hereunder in any future judicial or administrative proceeding in which the Board is a party;

6. I consent to the entry of the following Order affecting my license to practice medicine and surgery in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

ORDER

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Virginia Board of Medicine hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. Louis Beverly Brill, II, M.D., is REPRIMANDED.

2. Louis Beverly Brill, II, M.D., shall comply with all laws and regulations governing the practice of medicine in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Pursuant to Virginia Code §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record, and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.
